

Privacy Statement

iLogistics IT Solutions GmbH, Airportstraße 9, 2401 Fischamend, processes your personal data for certain purposes, which are detailed below.

I. Contact details of iLogistics IT Solutions GmbH as controller

II. Data processing activities

We process personal data of our website users only to the extent necessary to provide a functioning website and to contact us. For this purpose the following processing activities of personal data are carried out which we will inform you in detail below in accordance with Art 13 and Art 14 GDPR:

1. Data processing „Website Access“

1.1 Scope of processing of personal data

When accessing <https://ilogics.com> our system collects and stores information and data provided by your computer and its system used for the accessing. The following data are automatically collected via log files:

- Browser type
- Browser version
- Operating system used
- Referrer URL (of the previous page you visited)
- Host name of accessing computer / device
- Date and time of server enquiry.
- IP address
- Actual contents of the cookie information of <https://ilogics.com> (see below item 3)

1.2 Legal grounds for the processing of personal data

A temporary storage of certain automatically collected data is necessary for the security of our IT systems and to offer a user-friendly surfing experience, hence the legal basis for the processing is our legitimate interest within the meaning of Art 6 para 1 lit f GDPR.

1.3 Purpose of the data processing

Processing the IP address is necessary to enable the delivery of the website to your computer. For this purpose your IP address must remain stored for the duration of the session. Other data is stored in log files to ensure the functionality of the website including its functions and to optimize the website. We also process your personal data in order to detect, prevent and investigate attacks on our website.

Data collected will not provide a direct link or contain any references to a person in general. This information will not be collated with other data sources. However, we reserve the right to screen server log-files in case of a grounded indication of unlawful use of our website and therefore for the exercise of our legal rights.

An evaluation of the data collected for marketing purposes does not take place.

1.4 Duration of storage

All data collected here will be subject to deletion after a time period of max. 24 months.

1.5 Recipients of personal data

For operating the website we use technical service providers. In their capacity of being processors these providers are contractually bound by our orders and instructions for the processing of personal data.

No personal data will be disclosed to third parties for their own purposes without prior given consent.

2. Data processing „Direct communication“

2.1 Scope of processing of personal data

On our website we provide an electronic contact form to inquire of any kind of information about our company, our products and activities, vacancies or events. You may also contact us via E-Mail. We request the following data for this purpose: first name, last name, E-Mail address, telephone number, name of your company, content of your request.

You may voluntarily provide your personal data with us for your enquiry. However, if you do not provide us with these data, we may not be able to respond to your request.

In addition, we process the date of the request, the content of the completion of the request / order with time data, the name of the controllers representative handling your enquiry as well as the log data.

2.2 Legal grounds for the processing of personal data

The processing of these personal data is based on Art 6 para 1 lit b GDPR on the one hand in order to be able to process your enquiry as well as on the other hand on Art 6 para 1 lit f GDPR in order to be able to manage your enquiries and organise replies accordingly.

2.3 Purpose of the data processing

Personal data of customers, interested parties, applicants and other persons concerned are processed in order to handle their enquiries submitted via the online contact form on the website or by E-Mail. The purpose of the storage and processing of these data is the administration of messages, in particular the allocation of messages to the responsible employee as well as the handling of the inquiry resp. of contacting and the communication with the person concerned.

2.4 Duration of storage

Personal data will be stored up to a year after the last contact with us.

2.5 Recipients of personal data

For operating the website we use technical service providers. In their capacity of being processors these providers are contractually bound by our orders and instructions for the processing of personal data.

In addition, your submitted and processed data will be communicated internally if your contact can be attributed either to a business relationship with us or to an application for an open position.

No personal data will be disclosed to third parties for their own purposes without prior given consent.

3. Cookies

We use cookies on our website. By accessing the website and the fact you have allowed the acceptance of cookies by handling the corresponding settings of your browser, you may give your consent to the use of cookies. The relevant information regarding the type of cookies employed and the processing of data can be found below. You may withdraw your consent at any time by changing your browser settings (see instructions below).

Which data are collected, stored and processed?

When accessing our website technical information are stored on your device in the form of a so called "cookie". A cookie is a small data file that is transferred to your hard drive through your web browser.

Essential Cookies

iLogistics uses cookies which are necessary for the operation of the website <https://ilogics.com/> and the services offered via the website. This includes technologies that allow you to access the site and the services and are necessary to verify the functionality of the site as well as to prevent fraud and to improve security. These cookies are essential to use the website's services smooth and properly. However, these cookies are stored for the period being absolutely necessary for services to be carried out, i.e. until the end of the internet session and until you close your browser (session cookies).

Web Analytics Cookies

iLogistics uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc., 1600 Amphitheater Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA. This analytic service enables an analysis of the website usage by its cookies. These cookies are so-called „Third Party Cookies“. These data files are generating information which are transferred to and stored on servers hosted by Google, Inc. in the United States of America.

The following cookies are used for the purposes of web analytics:

_ga: this Google Analytics Cookie is used to distinguish between site visitors. This helps us to identify frequently visited website areas and hence, optimizing our web presence. The cookie does not enable an identification of users since no relevant personal data are processed. These permanent cookies expire usually after two years and are justified by our legitimate interest to conduct annual statistics on the usage of our website.

The information generated by the cookie about the usage of this website by users is generally transmitted to and stored by Google, Inc. on servers located in the United States. IP anonymisation has been activated on this website, hence the IP address of users accessing the website within member states of the European Union or in other states party to the Agreement on the European Economic Area is shortened before being stored on Google servers (so-called „IP masking“). On this account your full IP address will not be transmitted to a Google, Inc. server in the United States. iLogistics informs you that on this website Google Analytics has been extended by the code "gat._anonymizeIp();" in order to guarantee an anonymous collection of IP addresses.

On behalf of iLogistics, Google, Inc. will use this information for the purpose of evaluating the usage of the website by users, compiling reports on website activities and providing other services to website operators relating to website activities and internet usage.

You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser (so-called „Browser-Add-On“). However, please note that if you do not allow our cookies you may not be able to use the full functionality of our website. In addition, users can prevent Google, Inc. from collecting data generated by the cookie and related to their use of the website (including their anonymized IP address) as well as prevent Google, Inc. from processing these data by downloading

In addition to or as an alternative to the browser add-on, users may completely prevent Google Analytics from collecting data by clicking on the following link to [deactivate Google Analytics](#). An Opt-Out-Cookie is set, which prevents the future collection of user data when visiting this website.

This Opt-Out-Cookie does perform only for this browser and this domain, thus if you delete all cookies set in your browser you may carry out another download for this Opt-Out-Cookie.

Deactivating Cookies

Cookies may be modified and/or deleted as the user wishes to. You may find detailed information on the website of the browser you are using (e.g. Mozilla Firefox, Internet Explorer, Chrome).

You can delete all cookies stored on your computer and set most browsers to prevent cookies from being stored. However, you may then need to manually adjust several settings each time you visit the site and accept the impairment of some features and services.

III. Rights of the data subject

1. *Right of access*

You have the right to obtain all information about your personal data being processed by iLogistics. You may request access to the following information:

- (a) the purposes of the processing;
- (b) the categories of personal data concerned;
- (c) the recipients or categories of recipient to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed;
- (d) the envisaged period for which the personal data will be stored, or, if not possible, the criteria used to determine that period;
- (e) the existence of the right to request from the controller rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing of personal data concerning the data subject or to object to such processing;
- (f) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- (g) where the personal data are not collected from the data subject, any available information as to their source;
- (h) the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, referred to in Art 22 para 1 and 4 GDPR and, at least in those cases, meaningful information about the logic involved, as well as the significance and the envisaged consequences of such processing for the data subject.

You have the right to request information whether personal data are transferred to a third country or to an international organisation. If so, you have the right to be informed of the appropriate safeguards pursuant to Art 46 GDPR relating to the transfer.

2. *Right to rectification and right to restriction of processing*

You have the right to demand the correction or completion of incorrect or incomplete data. Under certain circumstances, such as when the accuracy of data is in dispute, you have the right to demand restriction of data processing activities until the correctness has been verified to the effect that data may be processed only with prior given consent or for the purpose of asserting, exercising or defending a right or protecting the rights of another natural or legal person or for reasons of important public interest.

3. Right to data portability

You have the right to receive the personal data concerning you, which you have provided iLogistics, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from iLogistics to which the personal data have been provided, where

- a) the processing is based on consent pursuant Art 6 para 1 lit a GDPR or Art 9 para 2 lit a GDPR or on a contract pursuant to Art 6 para 2 lit b GDPR; and
- b) the processing is carried out by automated means.

You have the right to have the personal data transmitted directly from iLogistics to another controller, where technically feasible. Freedoms and rights of other persons, including in particular trade and business secrets, in particular also those of the customer assigned to you, may not be affected by this.

4. Right to erasure

You may exercise the right to demand erasure of personal data under certain circumstances, such as when personal data are not processed in accordance with data protection requirements.

If you have asserted the right to rectification, deletion or restriction of data processing against us, we are obliged to notify all recipients to whom the personal data concerning you have been disclosed of this rectification or deletion or restriction of data processing, unless this proves impossible or involves disproportionate effort.

5. Right to object

You have the right to object to the processing of personal data based on Art 6 para 1 lit e or f GDPR at any time to grounds relating to your particular situation. This also applies to profiling based on these provisions.

6. Supervisory Authority

Notwithstanding the possibility of an action before the Regional Court pursuant to Section 29 para 2 of the Data Protection Act and any other remedies, the right to appeal to the competent national supervisory authority exists in case an unlawful processing of personal data is assumed by the data subject. In Austria, the data protection authority, Vienna is responsible.
